- ◎ **Paper containers for beverages** please refer to p. 8
(Cartons for *shochu* (distilled spirits)/milk /juice, etc.)

Paper Recycling ⇒ Combustible Waste

※ Milk cartons and paper pack for beverage will be collected at some supermarkets in Kobayashi

- ◎ **Plastic wraps, tubes, and small bags** please refer to p. 8
(small bags include everything up to a maximum size of about a pouch of re-heatable curry)

Plastic Containers & Packaging ⇒ Combustible Waste

※ With that said, however, for containers that are clean on the inside, you can continue to put these out as “plastic containers and packaging” as you have in the past.

- ◎ **Residential medical waste** please refer to p. 9
(solution transfusion bags, tubes, and stomas, etc.)

Non-combustible Waste ⇒ Combustible Waste

- ◎ Water absorbent sheets that are placed underneath meats and fish (material does not matter) please refer to p. 9

Plastic Containers & Packaging ⇒ Combustible Waste

Non-combustible Waste ※material does not matter

- ◎ **Pet bottle** please refer to p. 14

(Recyclable Waste)

Remove caps and leave labels intact.

Remove caps and labels.

※ Please sort labels depending on the logo mark that is shown on them.

Additional Item

- ◎ **Lithium-ion batteries** please refer to p. 17
These shall be collected as recycling waste (batteries).

※. Products where the lithium-ion battery is integrated into the product's body.

Mobile batteries.
