

## Put into a specific container

### metal



Items made mostly out of metal

- Cookware such as frying pans, pots, kettles
- Portable gas stoves, gas stoves, IH stovetops, storage water heaters (gas type)
- Industrial pipe clothing racks, wire hangers, metal clothes container, metal wardrobes
- Bicycles, unicycles, tricycles

Electronic items mostly made out of metal

- Fan heaters, kerosene heaters, Kotatsu heaters
- Electric kettles, microwaves, toasters, rice cookers
- Hot plates, bread machines, Mochi machines
- Fans, antennas, sewing machines

### Items that are easily mistaken

- Please dispose of vacuum cleaners, hair dryers, radios, and radio-cassette players as non-burnable waste.



### Requests

- Garbage that does not fit should be placed by the container
- If you dispose of a heater, remove the kerosene inside beforehand
- Clean any pots and portable cooking stoves as well as you can before disposing of them
- Please separate appliances that come with a power cord and those that don't

## Small appliances



Small home appliances

Small home appliances often contain rare metal. In order to recycle rare-metal, the Act for Recycling of Specified Kinds of Home Appliances has been enforced in 2013. Following 10 items are collected. Please put it in a container for the "small home appliances."

Power cords

- ⚠ Please remove any batteries from the appliances before throwing them out, and put them in the dedicated container

## Please tie the following items with a string before throwing away



- Newspapers, flyers
  - Magazines and documents
  - Cardboard
- You can tie newspaper and flyer together
  - Fliers and newspapers can be tied together
  - Paper that got wet can be thrown out as well

## Put into a specific container

### Lights and Bulbs



- Circular fluorescent bulbs
- Incandescent bulbs
- Straight tube fluorescent lamps
- Light starter

• You can throw lamps away even if they are broken, but please do not touch directly.

• LED bulbs should be thrown out with the unburnable garbage  
Please place them in a designated bag and put them out at the collection site.

### Used cooking oil



Please put your vegetable oils in a PET bottle and close the lid tightly.



- Cooking oil, sesame oil  
(vegetable edible oils only)

• Be careful to put the oil in a container that won't leak in case of a natural disaster or if it falls down by accident.

• Lard and tallow should be put out as burnable garbage.
