




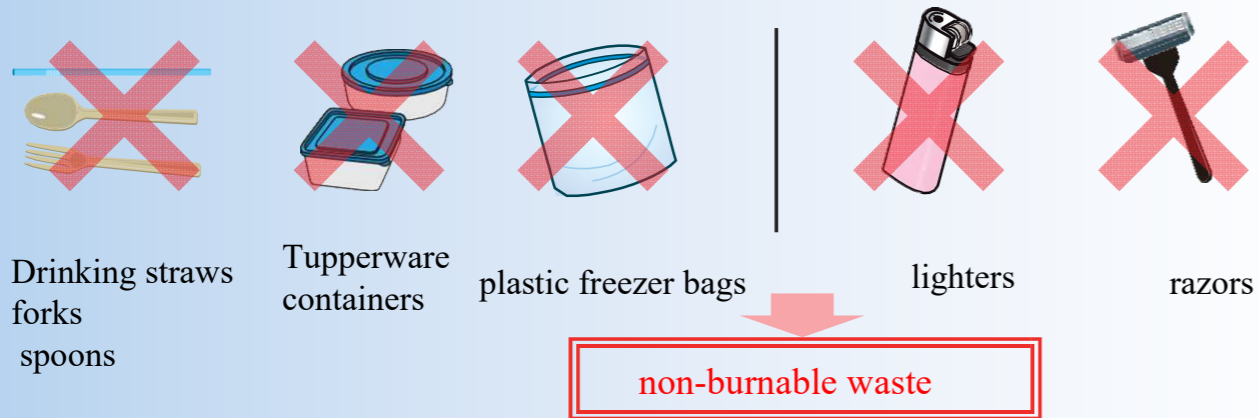
Plastic Containers & Packaging

Items that can be recycled even though they are made of plastic materials include plastic containers and packaging that is used to enclose products and they are indicated using a  mark and such materials are referred to as “plastic containers and packaging.”

 **First, check to make sure that there is a  mark displayed on it.**

Items that are easily mistaken

● Do not put these in the bag! These are not “plastic containers and packaging.”



Important Please clean off any filth, and dry them before placing them inside of a designated garbage bag. Do not separate them using shopping bags, etc., and place them directly into the designated garbage bag instead.

Bottles

- Bottles of detergent or bleach, Bottles of softener or air freshener
- Shampoo, conditioner
- Containers for eye drops and tablets
- Sauce and dressing containers
- Bottles containing soy sauce/condiments/cooking oil, etc.



Plastic cups and other containers

- Ice cream/gelatinous dessert/yogurt containers
- Margarine/butter/re-heatable cooked rice/miso paste containers
- Deodorant and dehumidifier containers
- Cartons and packaging used to contain eggs/tofu/natto/vegetables/prepared dishes
- Refill packs for shampoo/conditioner/liquid detergent, etc.



Collection: Once a week

Plastic Containers & Packaging

Trays

- Plastic trays
- Bento box trays
- Food packaging trays used for meat/fish, etc.



Lid, Cap

- PET bottle or glass bottle caps, Spray can caps.
- Plastic lids found on 1-*sho* (1.8-liter) bottles/bottles
- Pumps found on shampoo/conditioner bottles



Plastic bags, wraps

- Labels affixed to plastic bottles
- Plastic bags
- Individual wrappers and packaging used to contain snacks/food products/candy, etc.
- Disposable chopsticks and straw plastic wraps
- Instant noodles sauce packets
- Outer packaging film used for instant noodles/snacks



Others

- Blister packs (medicine)
- Fruits baskets, Fruit nets
- Cushioning materials used for protection in fruit baskets and for home appliances (shock absorption materials)
- Bubble wraps (package cushioning)
- Seeding pots
- Side dish or sushi trays
